In the Spring 2007 issue, in an article by William T. Dickens, Lorenz Goette, Erica L. Groshen, Steinar Holden, Julian Messina, Mark E. Schweitzer, Jarkko Turunen, and Melanie E. Ward called “How Wages Change: Micro Evidence from the International Wage Flexibility Project” (pp. 195–214), figures on p. 200 and p. 209 were mislabeled.

In Figure 1 on p. 200, the legend identifies the short dashed line as the normal distribution and the long dashed line as the Weibull distribution. However, it is the short dashed line that is the normal. In Figure 3 on p. 209, the legend identifies the lighter bars as Normal Rigidity and the darker bars as Real Rigidity. However, the lighter bars should be Real Rigidity and the darker bars should be Normal Rigidity.
