

Journal of Economic Literature

In 2021, the *Journal of Economic Literature* published 26 manuscripts in our Articles section: 14 articles and 12 review essays. This represents an increase of 5 manuscripts compared to 2020. We printed 18 regular book reviews, included 933 book abstracts in the Annotated Listing of New Books in 2021, and we listed 29 pages of PhD dissertation listings in the December 2021 issue. Table 1 shows the number of pages published each year, by section, from 1980 to 2021.

Editorial Board

The Board of Editors, as has always been the case, plays an essential role in the journal, both by reviewing papers under consideration and also by suggesting potential topics and authors for future papers. The terms of appointment for seven members of the board expired as of December 31, 2021, and two board members have stepped down prior to their terms ending due to new editorial responsibilities.
